INTRODUCTION

No two pieces of timber are the same.
Neither are the tables we make from them.

At RiverTable, we create individual pieces of furniture from some of nature's most remarkable materials.

Every table begins with the timber. Its grain, colour, knots, figuring, live edges and natural imperfections give us something completely unique to work with. Rather than trying to disguise that character, we design around it.

From the choice of timber and resin through to the proportions, base and final finish, each element is considered as part of the whole.

The result isn't a table selected from a catalogue and altered to fit. It is a piece designed around you, your space and the timber itself.

Made in Britain. Made individually. Made to last.

Our tables are created in our Essex workshop, combining traditional woodworking skills with modern materials, precision equipment and an uncompromising approach to finishing.

Whether we are creating a dining table for a family home, a centrepiece for a boardroom or something entirely individual, the principle remains the same.

Start with exceptional materials. Respect their character. And make something worth keeping.

Different spaces. Different purposes. *The same attention to detail.*

RiverTables are made individually, which means there is no fixed collection you have to choose from. Instead, we create a table around how and where it will be used.



i. Dining Tables

The place people naturally come together.

Designed around your room, the number of people you want to seat and the way you live — from generous family tables to dramatic statement pieces for larger spaces.



ii. Boardroom & Meeting Tables

A boardroom table should do more than fill a room.

Substantial bespoke tables for boardrooms, meeting rooms and commercial spaces, with options including integrated cable management, power and connectivity.



iii. Coffee & Occasional Tables

Smaller in scale, the same attention to detail.

A way to bring the character of a RiverTable into living spaces where a full-size dining table isn't required.

Extraordinary tables

The timber you choose sets the tone for your table. Each species has its own character, colour and grain — and every slab brings something different again.



i. Oak

Strong, timeless and unmistakably natural. Oak offers beautiful grain variation, warm colouring and enormous versatility, and its character works equally well in traditional interiors and contemporary architectural spaces.



ii. Walnut

Rich, dark and distinctive. Walnut ranges from warm chocolate and coffee tones through to lighter sapwood, often within the same slab, creating a sophisticated, dramatic table with exceptional natural contrast.



iii. Elm

Full of movement and character. Elm is renowned for its interlocking grain, tonal variation and distinctive figuring. Where the timber itself should become the main visual feature, it is an exceptional choice.



iv. Cherry

Warm, refined and beautifully understated. Cherry has a naturally smooth grain and warm colouring that deepens with age. Elegant rather than dramatic, it produces beautifully balanced furniture.

Not sure which timber is right for you? That's part of what we're here for.



NATURAL CHARACTER

Perfectly *imperfect.*

Cracks · Knots · Burrs · Voids · Live edges · Changes in colour and grain

In mass-produced furniture these might be treated as imperfections. We see them differently.

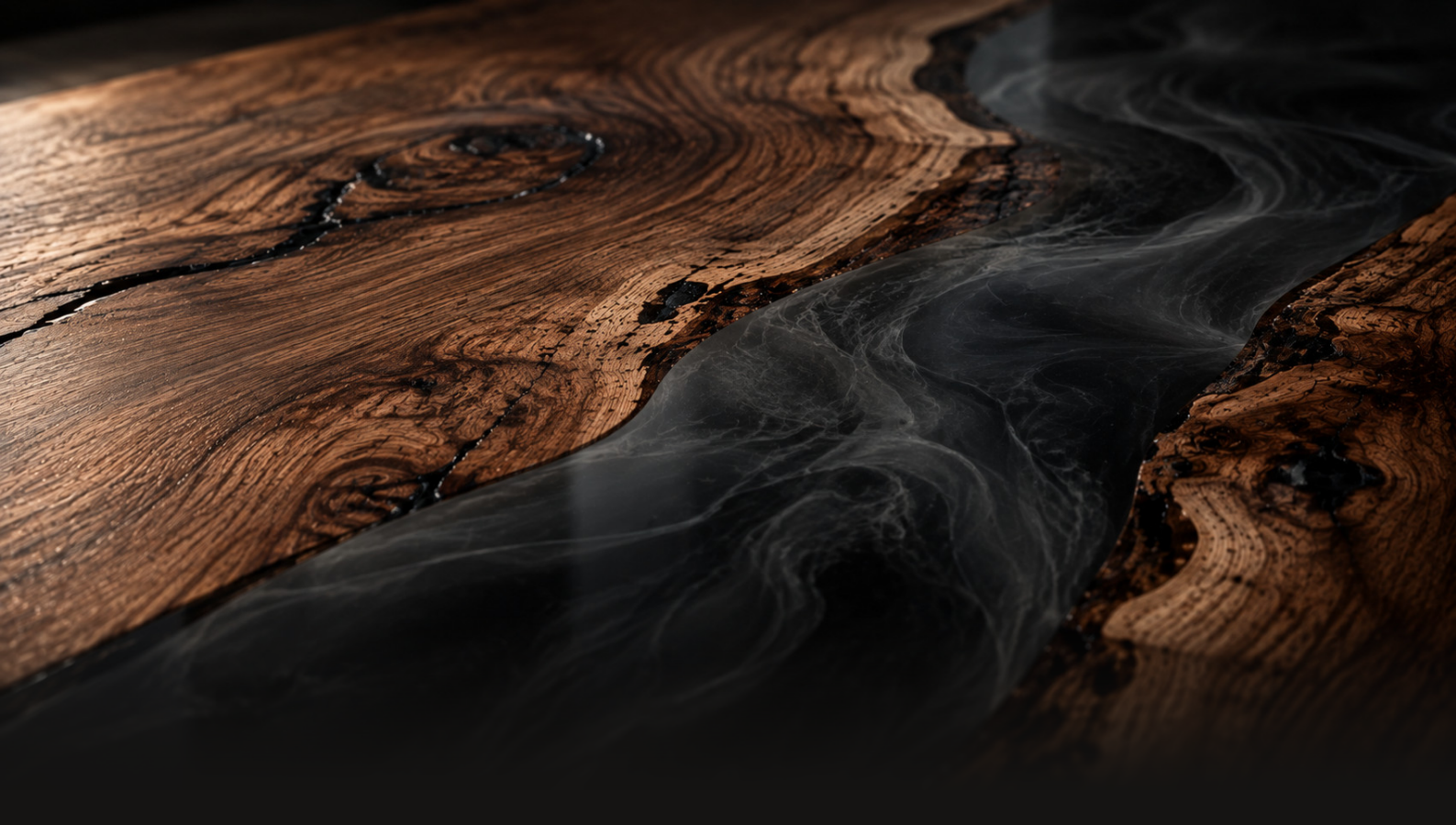
They are the evidence that the material we are working with was once a living tree — and they are often the details that ultimately define the finished table.

Our role isn't to make every slab look the same. It is to understand what makes an individual piece of timber special and design a table that celebrates it.

Your table will be unique.

Natural timber varies from slab to slab, and resin pours develop their own subtle movement and character. That means your finished RiverTable will never be an exact duplicate of another.

We think that is precisely the point.



RESIN

Add colour. *Or barely add it at all.*

Resin gives us another dimension to work with. It can create dramatic contrast, quietly complement the timber or simply fill natural voids while the character of the wood remains dominant.

From deep blacks and smoky translucent tones to blues, metallics and completely individual colour combinations, there is enormous freedom.

The objective is never to add resin simply for the sake of it. It is to find the balance that works with the timber, the design and the room the finished table will occupy.

Your colour. Your choice.

We offer a carefully selected range of resin colours and effects, but you are not restricted to a set palette. If you have a colour in mind — from your interior scheme, a company colour or simply a shade you love — we can explore it with you.

This is where your table *becomes yours.*

Choosing the timber is only the beginning. Because every RiverTable is made individually, we can consider each element of the design around you and your space.



i.

Size & Proportion

Length, width, height and overall proportions, tailored to the room and the number of people the table needs to seat.

ii.

Timber Selection

Choose from available slabs by species, colouring, grain, live edge and natural character.

iii.

Resin

From subtle transparent and smoky finishes through to bold colours and metallic effects.

iv.

Bases & Legs

The base shapes the character of a table. We explore materials, profiles and styles to find the right balance.

v.

Edge & Finish

Live edge or refined. Natural or contemporary. Every detail shapes how the finished table feels.

vi.

Commercial Integration

Cable access, power, charging and connectivity for boardrooms, without compromising the design.

From a piece of timber to your *finished table*.

Commissioning something bespoke doesn't need to be complicated. We guide you through each decision and keep the process straightforward, from the first conversation to delivery.

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| 01 | Tell us what you have in mind | What you are looking for, where the table will sit, approximate dimensions and any ideas or references you already have. |
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| 02 | Choose your timber | We help you explore suitable species and available slabs, considering grain, colouring, character and proportion. |
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| 03 | Develop the design | With the timber selected, we bring together the resin, dimensions, base, edges, finish and any other requirements. |
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| 04 | We make it | Handcrafted in our Essex workshop. Resin is poured, timber is carefully machined and prepared, and the table moves through multiple stages of sanding and finishing. |
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| 05 | The finishing touches | This is where patience matters. We refine the surface, edges and finish until everything works together exactly as it should. |
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| 06 | Delivery | Once complete, your RiverTable is prepared for delivery and installation in its new home. |

— CRAFTSMANSHIP

Made by hand. *Helped by technology.*

There is no shortcut to making exceptional furniture. Machinery gives us extraordinary accuracy, but machines don't decide which part of a slab should become the focal point of a table. They don't feel a surface, refine an edge or know when a finish is right. That comes from experience.

We machine where precision matters.
We work by hand where judgement matters.
And we take our time where the finish matters.

Much of what separates an ordinary table from an exceptional one happens long after the basic shape is made. These are the stages you may never see. But you will see the result.

— MADE FOR REAL LIFE

Furniture should *be used.*

A RiverTable may be a statement piece, but it is still a table. It should be sat around, worked at, eaten from, talked over and lived with — so durability and practicality are considered alongside appearance throughout.

Natural timber will continue to respond subtly to its environment. Look after it properly and, rather than simply getting older, it develops character.

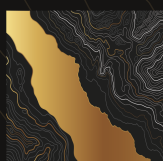
